**We're currently looking for two Exceptional families
to be part of our webseries.**

The Exceptional Life is a documentary webseries being produced for **Autism Speaks Canada**, with support from **Community Living** and the **Rotary Club**. The series follows Dr. Joelene Huber (a developmental pediatrician) and Sarah Davis (a Behaviour Therapist) as they support families that have a child diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD). The team will provide families with support using applied behaviour analysis (ABA), which has been demonstrated to be an effective approach to make meaningful change in behaviour.

We're currently looking for:

- a family with a young child diagnosed with an ASD
- a family with a teen or young adult diagnosed with an ASD

Note: Participating families must be available for 3 non-consecutive day of filming in July 2018.

Dr. Huber and Sarah will guide each family to support their child's development with a specific skill. At this time we are we're looking to help with any of the following:

- early language skills (e.g., requesting items, labelling items, using augmentative communication systems)
- advanced social skills (e.g., dating etiquette, job readiness)
- daily living (e.g., toilet training, food selectivity, undefined sleep schedule)

Dr. Huber and Sarah have both worked with many children diagnosed with ASD and their families. **The Exceptional Life** allows us an intimate look into how they support parents to teach their child diagnosed with ASD . We hope that viewers are drawn into the personal stories of our families and at the end will come away with tools to help them in their own journey with their child.
