Funding sources

- Traditional funding
 - Government
 - Fundraising
 - User fees

Funding sources

- Innovative funding
 - While relying on traditional funding sources a new idea is introduced
 - Business model is attached to the non-for-profit
 - Non-for –profit selling
 - Social Enterprise
 - B-Corporation

Business models

- Non-for-profit selling
 - Occasional sales (art show, local market, etc.), occasional profit is made
- Social Enterprise
 - Business idea is formed and operated, ongoing profit is made
- B-Corporation
 - Benefit corporation or B-corporation is a type of for-profit corporate entity that includes positive impact on society and the environment in addition to profit as its legally defined goals

DANI Social Enterprise Model

It's a 'hand up', not a 'hand out'

What is a Social Enterprise?

- A business venture with a social twist
- Works like a business
- Profit is generated
- Vocational training possibilities
- Preparation for the open job market

A business venture with a social twist

- Builds on community support
- Open to the public
- Niche market research (A **niche market** is the subset of the **market** on which a specific product is focused)

Works like a business

- Professionally run and managed
- Market value/market price

Profit is generated

- Just like any other business, there is a profit margin
- No shareholders
- Profit is turned back into the non-for-profit organization's budget

Vocational training possibilities

- Participants are trained in the business
- Participants take pride in the work they do
- Once trained and working; participants are paid (market value!!!!)

Preparation for the open job market

- Social enterprise is somewhat sheltered
- Open market employers need training and ongoing support
- Participants need ongoing support
- Buffer between employers and employees
