How To Stay Safe When You Go To Get The Vaccine

- Wear a mask
- Wash your hands
- Make sure you feel healthy!





Tell your caregivers and doctor if:

- If you feel sick (cough, vomit, runny nose)
- If you are feeling scared



What To Do Before The Vaccine

- It is important to wear a mask if you are able to wear one
- Make sure to wear a short sleeve shirt!

You will have to come back to get another vaccine in a few weeks.

This is important to ensure the vaccine works well to protect you from COVID!







What Will Happen When You Get The Vaccine?

• A doctor or nurse will come see you



• They will clean your arm with a wipe



You may feel a small pinch



 Once its all done, your arm may feel sore or be a little red- but that's normal!

What Happens After You Get The Vaccine?

You will wait in the office until the nurse tells you that you can go.

You can have a snack or treat if you want, you did so well!

Your arm may feel sore for a little while, but if you feel sick, tell your caregivers and they can help!



Your body will become stronger and help protect you from COVID-19





When You Get Home You Should Tell Your Caregiver If:

- 1. You don't feel well
- 2. You have itchy bumps on your body
- 3. You feel hot and sweaty
- 4. Your face feels funny or you can't breathe well



REMEMBER!

You still need to remain safe in your community!

It's still important to:

- Wear your mask
- Wash your hands or use sanitizer
- Say hello or wave when greeting others
