- Acrylic Paint (Colours of your choice) \$1.49 each from Michaels and they also sell paint sets ranging from \$14.99 to \$39.99 with multiple colours.
- Mod Podge Matte Finish Michaels Canada 4 oz \$6.99

INSTRUCTIONS

- Gather all materials for the activity,
- Paint the base of the clay the colour of your choices of this activity we are painting this one Red. As well as the saucer.
- Allow the paint to dry.
- Once the pain had dried paint two white circles at the top, let dry then add two small black circles to make the eyes.
- Make wings two wings at the front with black paint and black circles around the spots.
- Once dry add a layer of mod podge to the pot to seal it.

SUPPORTS NEEDED

Supports will vary depending on the individuals needs.

OTHER THINGS TO NOTE:

Once the pots are dried, add in soil and plants. Be sure to water the plants as needed to keep them alive and healthy.
