WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

TIME

Time will be based on your event, a minimum of 1 hour is required

MATERIALS

Include any necessary or suggested materials needed for the activity.

- Disposal bags
- Recycling Bags
- Organic bags
- Rubber gloves
- Garbage grabbers(if wanted)
- Hand sanitizer
- Signs (to advertise event)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Plan a date for community clean up, could coincide with Earth Day on 3rd Saturday/Sunday of April

2. Choose a public space or small park in your community.
3. Invite your neighbors, check with your city, or town to inform them of your clean up
4. Set up a meeting spot based on your day/time to meet other volunteers
5. Create signs and set up a meeting area to provide supplies for volunteers
6. Have a table set up for snacks and drinks and sign in
7. Take lots of pictures to share on social media
