Collaborative Flower PaintingPainting



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WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This activity involves a community aspect, in which everyone contributes to a bundle of flowers. It introduces artists to the concept of blending and gradients.

TIME

This activity should take up to an hour.

MATERIALS

- Acrylic Paint Set (\$10)
- Paint brushes, one flat, one round.
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Cups
- Water

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Take a pencil and draw a circle with 6 petals around it.
- 2. Take a flat paint brush and add purple, pink, and white onto the brush in that order.
- 3. Paint one petal in a curved motion. Continue till the circle is complete.
- 4. Dot the flower with the darkest colour.
- 5. Cut out the flowers.
- 6. Repeat the steps with different colour gradients, aim to use a minimum one colour with white on the brush.
- 7. Glue the bundle of flowers together.
