WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This activity lets people experiment with making collages and helps them think deeply about how to creatively arrange them. It offers freedom and a way to tell powerful stories. Participants can express their likes and interests creatively. This activity not only has individual experimenting with the art of collage, but it also has them thinking deeply about composition. It allows freedom and powerful storytelling. Individuals get a chance to express their likes/interests through their creative expression.

TIME

This activity can take 30 minutes to 1 hour.

MATERIALS

- Magazines, newspapers
- Laptop + printer (if necessary)
- Paper/Bristol board (Dollar store \$2)
- Scissor
- Glue/tape
- Markers
- Optional: stickers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Select images from magazines, newspapers, or even the internet (if you have access to a laptop and printer) of things you like. As the theme of this collage is the alphabet, you should aim to collect 26 items, each starting with each letter in the alphabet.



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2. Once you have selected your images feel free to cut them out and place them how you'd like on the Bristol board/paper – try to fill the page as best you can.
3. Once you have your desired placement, glue or tape each picture onto the board/paper.
4. Use a marker to write down each letter right below each image.
5. Add stickers if you'd like.
