# **Rainbow Collage**

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#### WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This activity not only has individual experimenting with the art of collage, but it also has them thinking deeply about composition. This activity has the individual experimenting with the art of collage and putting something together, in a fun, colourful and creative way.

#### TIME

This activity can take 30 minutes to 1 hour.

#### **MATERIALS**

Include any necessary or suggested materials needed for the activity.

- Magazines
- Scissor
- Bristol board (Dollar store \$2)
- Glue

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Using magazines cut out the different colours of the rainbow (Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet) into different shapes. Try to collect as many tiny pieces of each colour as you can.
- 2. Cut out the shape of a rainbow from a piece of Bristol board. Sketching out the shape beforehand can make this process easier.
- 3. Using glue, glue the pieces onto the paper to resemble a rainbow.
