WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGEUL

A wind chime is a hanging decoration that makes soft, musical sounds when the wind blows through it. They are meaningful because they bring a sense of calm and tranquility, often associated with peaceful environments. The gentle music of wind chimes can soothe the mind, enhance outdoor spaces, and create a connection with nature through the harmonizing sounds they produce (Moana Nursery).

TIME

15-30 minutes

MATERIALS

There's a couple things you can use to make an at home wind chime:

- Metal straws (\$10+)
- Empty Cans (\$1+)
- Wind Chime kits (\$20+)
- Sticks
- Or any other material that can be tied with a string and makes a sound when they crash together... Get creative! Beads, coins, keys, shells! You name it!

To tie the chimes:

- String (\$5+)
- OR wire (\$10+)
- OR yarn (\$5+)

To hold it all together:

Paper plate (\$5+ in a pack)

DIY Wind Chime

- OR cardboard
- OR a stick
- OR any other material that can hold together all of your charms

Decoration (Optional)

- Paint
- glitter
- stickers
- Other decorative materials you may have

Instructions

- 1. Collect all of your 'charms.' For this example I will be using sticks.
- 2. Now is the time to decorate if you want! Or keep it natural!
 - a. This time, I would paint the sticks, put stickers on the paper plate and choose a nice colourful string. This is all up to personal preference! Interchange the decorative materials and how you use them. Customize your piece to the fullest!
- 3. Next, tie the string around your sound making material and keep the sting its attached to long so you can tie it to the base later
- 4. Once you've got all your charms tied onto strings, take your paper plate or cardboard and use a pencil to poke holes at the top
 - a. For example, If i had 6 sticks, I would poke 6 holes in my base
- 5. Next, take the long end of the string and pull it through the holes in the base and tie big knots so they don't fall through
- 6. Finally, poke one last hole through the middle of the base and loop your string through it to make something that will hang up your wind chime with
- 7. Set it outside, or in front of a light fan and enjoy the sounds of your creation!
