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WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

MATERIALS

- Magazines or printed fashion photos (you can find these online or in fashion magazines)
- Scissors (safety scissors for younger participants)
- Glue stick or craft glue
- Large sheet of paper or a poster board
- Markers or colored pens (optional)
- Decorative items like stickers or glitter (optional)

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INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Gather Your Materials: Collect magazines, printed photos, and other materials that you want to include in your collage. Find images of clothes, accessories, patterns, or anything related to fashion that you like.
- 2. Plan Your Design: Think about the theme or style you want for your collage. Do you want it to be colorful, trendy, or focused on a particular fashion era? Lay out your images on the paper to get an idea of how you want them to be arranged.
- 3. Cut Out Your Images: Carefully cut out the images and fashion items you want to use. Try to cut around the edges neatly so your collage will look clean and organized. You can cut out specific details or whole outfits—whatever you like!
