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WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

Learning how to grow your own plant, is a meaningful activity and helps you to learn how to grow your own plants, or flowers. It helps to teach responsibility, and creativity. Working with the natural world helps to relax and increases observation skills as you can see the plant growth over time. This activity is a great way to combine art and plants for a personal touch.

TIME

Include how long the activity can take, ranges are okay.

MATERIALS

- Empty cleaned 2 litre bottle (Free)
- Paint (\$15.00)
- Scissors (\$5.00)
- Soil (\$10.00)
- Plant (\$10.00)

INSTRUCTIONS

Include any instructions needed:

1. First decide what animal or design you like to do, and sketch it out on the plastic before cutting. When doing your design remember that you should cut off around half the bottle, so the pot isn't very deep.
2. Once the plastic is cut into the desired shape you can paint the outside.
3. After the paint is dried you must fill the pots with soil and put a plant in it.
