

# COMMUNITY INTEGRATION THROUGH CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION (CICE) | 2024-25

2 years, Certificate Kingston, Brockville, Cornwall (Code 0790) September Intake

#### **OVERVIEW**

The CICE program is for students with developmental disabilities, intellectual disabilities, acquired brain injury, or other significant learning challenges who require a modified program who want to experience college and develop academic and workforce skills.

### **PROGRAM COMPONENTS**

- ✓ Develop learning strategies and employability skills in core CICE courses
- ✓ Apply and practice employability skills in a variety of work placements
- ✓ Take courses in two or more elective areas (e.g. Culinary, Carpentry, Fine Arts - Visual & Creative Arts, Vet Assistant, Early Childhood Education, etc.)

### **SUPPORTS**

The CICE program provides academic support which includes:

- preparing notes and providing tutoring sessions
- assisting with assignment/homework completion and preparing for tests
- building independent learning skills
- implementing modifications and accommodations

#### **CAREER OPPORTUNITIES**

CICE graduates are prepared for a variety of entry-level jobs and volunteer opportunities.











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#### **PROGRAM GOALS**

- Build vocational and academic skills such as:
  - Social and communication skills
  - Job skills
  - o independence
- Develop friendships and social networks
- Participate in college and campus life

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Applications received by February 1 will be given first consideration. Applications will continue to be accepted after this date until the program is full.

In order to be considered, the following are required:

- Ontario Secondary School Certificate (OSSC) or an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or a Certificate of Accomplishment, equivalent, or mature student
- Demonstration of academic needs that require curriculum modification in order to succeed (i.e. Individual/Annual Education Plan (IEP)(AEP), Psychological Educational Assessment, or other supporting documentation)
- Two confidential references

- a level of independence which does not require constant support and supervision
- a willingness to participate fully in the program
- ability to participate in programming without risk to health and safety of self and others
- use the city bus or provide transportation to and from the college and field placement locations
- communicate thoughts, ideas, and needs clearly and in a focused manner
- a comfort using technology to support success
