TIME

MATERIALS

- Glue (\$3.00)
- Pompoms (\$6.00)
- Paper (\$3.50)
- Empty tissue box (Free)
- Paint (\$15.00)
- Feathers and other decorations

INSTRUCTIONS

Include any instructions needed:

1. First thing you will do is remove the plastic from the inside of the tissue box.

- 2. Then you can paint the box with whatever colors or designs you want. And paint the inside of the box black
- 3. Then cut out any type of teeth you want and glue it to the inside of the box so that you can see them.
- 4. Glue some googly eyes onto to some pom poms and attach them to the top of the box
- 5. Decorate some more with feathers and paint to finished it off
