WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

Skribbl.io is a fun and low-pressure way to practice communication, creativity, turn-taking, and teamwork. Participants can draw, guess, and laugh together while developing digital skills and engaging socially in a playful setting.

TIME

- **20–45 minutes** (each round lasts about 10–15 minutes; can play multiple rounds)

MATERIALS

- Computers, tablets, or laptops with internet access
- Internet connection (Wi-Fi or data)
- <https://skribbl.io> open in a browser
- Optional: projector or screen sharing for group play
- Optional: paper and markers for offline drawing practice



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to the website

- a. Visit www.skribbl.io
- b. Click “Create Private Room” if playing with a group you know

2. Set up the game

- a. Choose number of rounds (2–3 recommended)
- b. Select or type in word categories (e.g., animals, food, shapes)
- c. Copy and share the invite link with other players

3. Join the Game

- a. Each participant enters a name and joins via the shared link
- b. Optional: customize avatars

4. Start the Round

- a. One player draws while others guess the word by typing in the chat
- b. Players get points for guessing correctly or having others guess their drawing
- c. Take turns being the drawer

5. End of Game

- a. After the final round, celebrate everyone's creativity and teamwork!

SUPPORTS NEEDED

- **Visual examples** of how to play (step-by-step images or demo)
- **Simplified categories** (pre-select easy words or themes like animals or shapes)
- **Use of verbal prompts** during guessing (e.g., “It starts with a B!”)
- **Allow team play:** pair participants for support (e.g., one draws, one types)

- **Alternative options** for those who prefer not to draw (take guessing role only)
- **Encouragement and turn-taking support** (“It’s your turn to draw next!”)
- **Time cues and reminders:** “Almost done drawing—5 more seconds!”
- **Keyboard or motor assistance** if needed for typing or drawing
- **Safe space for trying:** focus on fun, not perfect spelling or art

OTHER THINGS TO NOTE

- If typing answers will be difficult, rules can be changed to whoever shouts the answer first gets the point
