Tissue Paper Mosaic





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WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This activity will leave you with a beautiful mosaic that can be hung anywhere with light to make a beautiful home decor piece. This craft encourages self-expression, by choosing what shape you want to do, as well as the colours. It also works on fine motor skills and can help improve hand eye coordination.

Not to mention completing a craft can give a sense of accomplishment and pride.

TIME

This activity would take 30–35 minutes.

MATERIALS

- Contact paper (\$8)
- Construction paper (\$6)
- Tissue paper (\$5)
- Scissors (\$5)
- Yarn (\$6)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use the construction paper and cut out a symmetrical shape that you like (Circle, Heart, diamond, or even butterfly). Fold the paper in half and cut out a border that is half one inch thick.
- 2. Cut a piece of contact paper slightly bigger than the shape you have, peel the backing off the paper and stick the paper frame on the sticky side.
- 3. Cut a wide range of tissue paper squares and place them on the sticky side of the contact paper, make sure they are touching so that all the inside is covered.

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- 4. Take a second piece of contact paper and stick it sticky side to sticky side to seal in all the tissue paper.
- 5. Once that is done, cut around the outline of the construction paper to get rid of excess contact paper.
- 6. Cut a small hole near the top of the design and put a string through it, tie a knot, and then you are ready to hang it up anywhere!
