WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

In many cultures, suncatchers symbolize hope, light, and positive energy. Creating them is a fun and soothing experience. Suncatchers are normally hung by a window to let light shine through them. When you see this, it invokes a sense of joy and calm.

TIME

- Prep: 20-30 minutes
- Drying: At least 24 hours
- Final (punching hole, ribbon, hanging): 5 minutes

MATERIALS

- A lid (any type of lid will work)
- Clear glue
- Food colouring
- Toothpick
- Hole puncher
- Ribbon

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill your lid up with clear glue.
2. Add drops of food coloring into the glue.
3. Use the toothpick to carefully swirl the colors together.

4. Let completely dry (best to let it sit for a full 24 hours).
5. Use a hole punch at the top & tie a ribbon through.
6. Hang in the window & enjoy!
