WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This craft promotes sustainability and using material that already exists, to reduce overall waste. We will be making a little house out of recycled toilet paper rolls and paper towel rolls. With this craft being sustainable in gloves another opportunity for people to use their creativity and imagination to make something out of something that already exists.

TIME

This activity would take 30 minutes.

MATERIALS

- Used paper towel roll or toilet paper roll
- Scissors
- paint
- glue

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Firstly you want to cut the paper towel roll or toilet paper roll to your desired length of the house
- 2. Next cut out 1 or 2 windows as well as a door at the front of the house.
- 3. Use extra toilet paper roll or paper towel roll and cut a rectangle that can fit on the top as the roof. Use the glue to secure it on the top.
- 4. Once you are happy with the holes you can start to paint, let your creativity take control here. Use bright colours and cool designs.
