Elephant Hand Print

WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This craft shows that not all art processes are the same, for this craft one of the goals is to use your hands and get messy, which isn't often asked when doing a craft. Having the opportunity to get your hands dirty while still creating something that is beautiful says a lot about how art can come from anything.

TIME

This activity would take 20 minutes.

MATERIALS

- A small canvas
- paint
- Marker

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. First if you want to paint your background a colour, do that before you begin the second part of the craft
- 2. Once your canvas is dry, paint your hand with a blue grey color and put it on the canvas, so that your hand print is upside down. The hand print will be the elephant. where the thumb in the trunk, the fingers and the legs, and the palm is the body of the elephant.
- 3. Once that paint dries you can go in with marker and draw on eyes and ear of the elephant and add more detail to the trunk.
