Toilet Paper Firework Craft

WHAT MAKES IT MEANINGFUL

This craft promotes sustainability and using material that already exists, to reduce overall waste. By using the toilet paper roll before throwing it out you can give garbage a second life. And it can also help you to make an awesome craft.

TIME

This activity would take 15 minutes.

MATERIALS

- Used paper towel roll or toilet paper roll
- Scissors
- paint
- Paper plate
- black paper

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. First you must cut the toilet paper roll length wise, cut it up for about \(\frac{3}{2} \).
- 2. Fill your paper plate with a color of your choosing, just make sure it is bright enough to show up on the black paper.
- 3. Put the toilet paper roll in it so that the strips all go flat and into the paint, then using the toilet paper roll as a stamp, stamp it on the black piece of paper.
- 4. You can then dip your toilet paper stamp into a bunch of different colors and either layer the colors or make a bunch of color bursts. And at this point I am sure you will see that they start to look like fireworks.
