

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT: BUILDING OUR FUTURE

Down Syndrome Foundation Canada is launching a new pilot training program in partnership with the Ontario Ministry of Labour's Skills Development Fund. This program will train people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) to become Supported Co-Workers, giving them hands-on experience and opening doors to rewarding careers in the skilled trades.



NEW TRAINING SESSIONS

This schedule outlines the sessions for both Cohort 1 and the newly added Cohort 2. Both groups utilize the same location and daily time slot, resulting in a three-month overlap of concurrent training.
