What is person-directed planning?

Person-directed planning helps youth with developmental disabilities identify goals and access community resources, services, and supports, with help from their families or significant others of their choice.

Planning is guided by the individual's personal goals. Examples include:

- Identifying abilities and interests
- Making connections to social and recreational activities
- Developing independence skills
- Finding volunteer, employment, and/or educational opportunities if appropriate
